	e) Be at least 51% black women owned; and/orf) Have at least 51% black ownership in black designated groups. Black designated groups mean:
	 I. Unemployed black people not attending and not required by law to attend an educational institution and not awaiting admission to an education institution; II. Black people who are youth as defined in the National Youth Commission Act, 1996;
	III. Black people who are persons with disabilities as defined in the Code of Good Practice on employment of people with disabilities issued under the Employment Equity Act, 1998;
	IV. Black people as defined in the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2013 living in rural and underdeveloped areas;
	 V. Black military veterans who qualify to be called military veteran in terms of the Military Veterans Act 18, 2011.
Evaluation criteria	Applicants that meet the above qualifying criteria will further be evaluated based on the quality of proposal that is submitted in terms of the attached application form. The applicant that scores the highest points out of a total of 100 points during the evaluation of their application will be considered for the programme.
